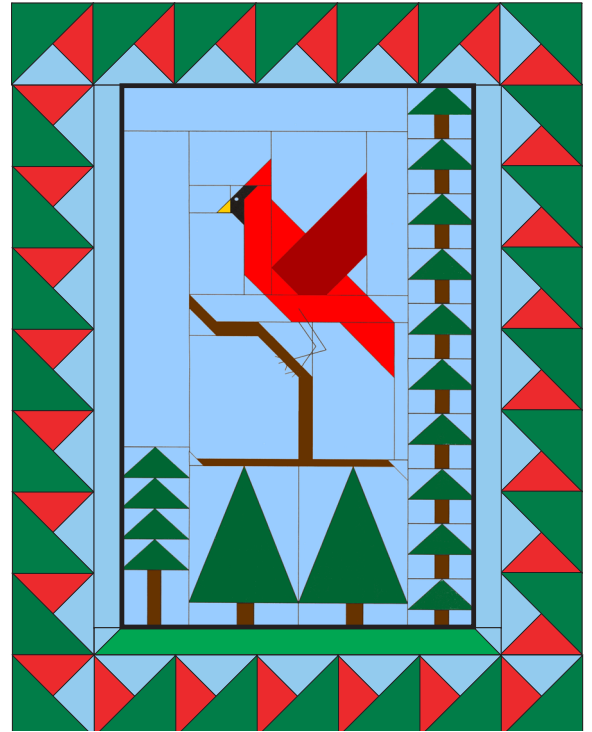




# Border for #103

## "Cardinal in the Woods" 21" x 27"

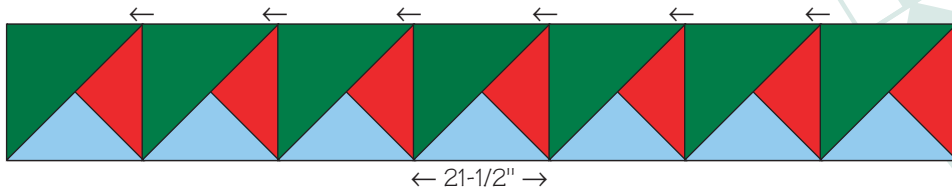
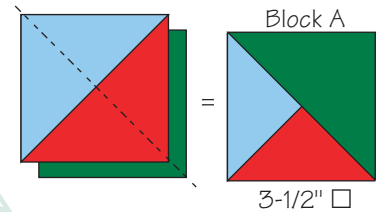
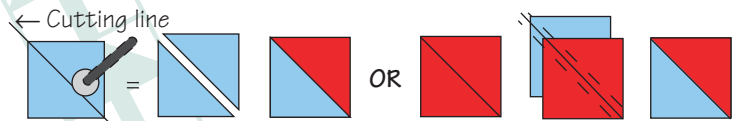
Usage/Yardage	Amount
Sky	two, 1-1/2" x 20-1/2"
- Need 1/3 yd more than listed on pattern.	two, 1-1/2" □
Green (for "grass")	fourteen 3-7/8" □
Red -need 1/4 yd	one, 1-1/2" x 15-1/2"
Dark Green -need 5/8 yd (includes binding, cut 2-1/2")	fourteen, 3-7/8" □
	twenty eight, 3-1/2" □



Heavy black line indicates original Cardinal in the Woods pattern.

Assemble cardinal wallhanging as given in pattern.

- Sew sky 1-1/2" x 20-1/2" to both sides of cardinal.
- Sew sky 1-1/2" □ FC to ends of grass 1-1/2" x 15-1/2". The cardinal block is now 15-1/2" x 21-1/2". Sew below cardinal.
- Cut the sky and red 3-7/8" □'s in half diagonally to make twenty eight Δ's of each. Sew a sky Δ to a red Δ to make twenty eight ▀. They are 3-1/2" □.
- Place a sky/red ▀ RST with a dark green 3-1/2" □. Sew diagonally **across** the sky/red seam. Press the green toward the corner. (This is really a Folded Corner) This block A is 3-1/2" □. Make twenty eight.
- Make two rows of seven A blocks. Sew to sides of cardinal.



- Make two rows of seven A blocks. **Note the end block is rotated.** Sew these to the top and bottom of the cardinal.
