

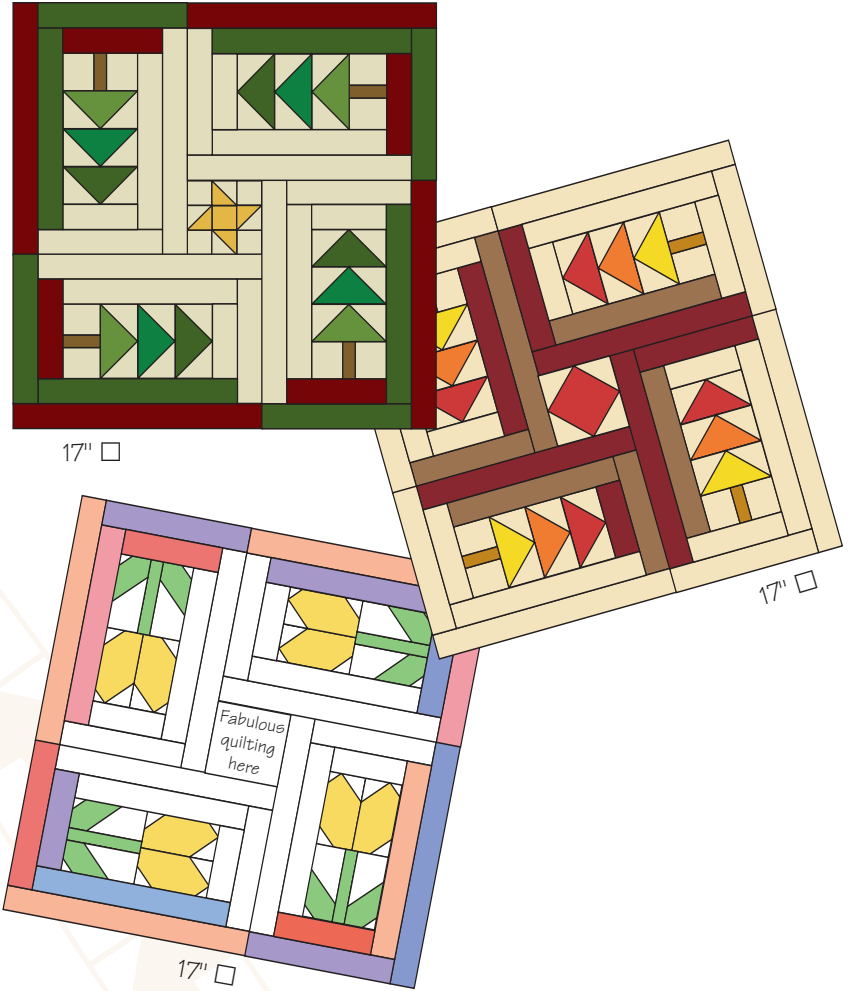


"Sunshine & Shadows Tabletopper"

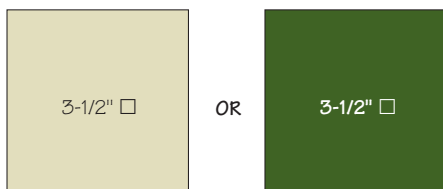
using pattern #308

Use yardage requirements as given on pages listed below. Borders are optional; see step 5.

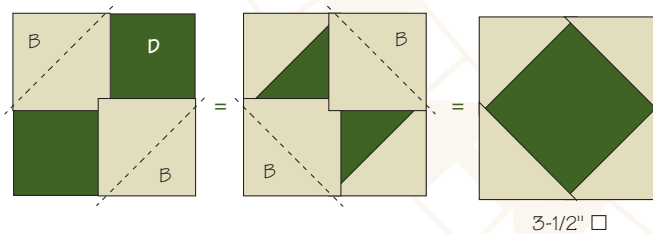
1. Refer to page 13 in pattern to cut pieces for four tree blocks, quantities as given. Cut background, trees, tree trunks, darks, and sashing. You may also select to make the same project with flowers instead of trees; see page 14 for cutting chart.
2. Assemble trees or flowers as given in instructions on page 12.
3. Select and cut center square. There are three options given below.
 - Cut one plain 3-1/2" □, light or dark.
 - or*
 - Cut one dark 3-1/2" □ and four 2" □ background. Assemble a "square in a square" as shown.
 - or*
 - Cut one 1-1/2" □ star and two 1-7/8" □ star. Plus, four 1-1/2" background and two 1-7/8" background. Assemble star as shown.



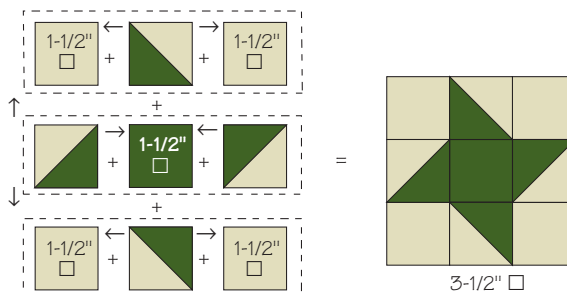
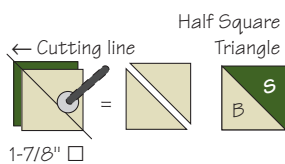
Center square options

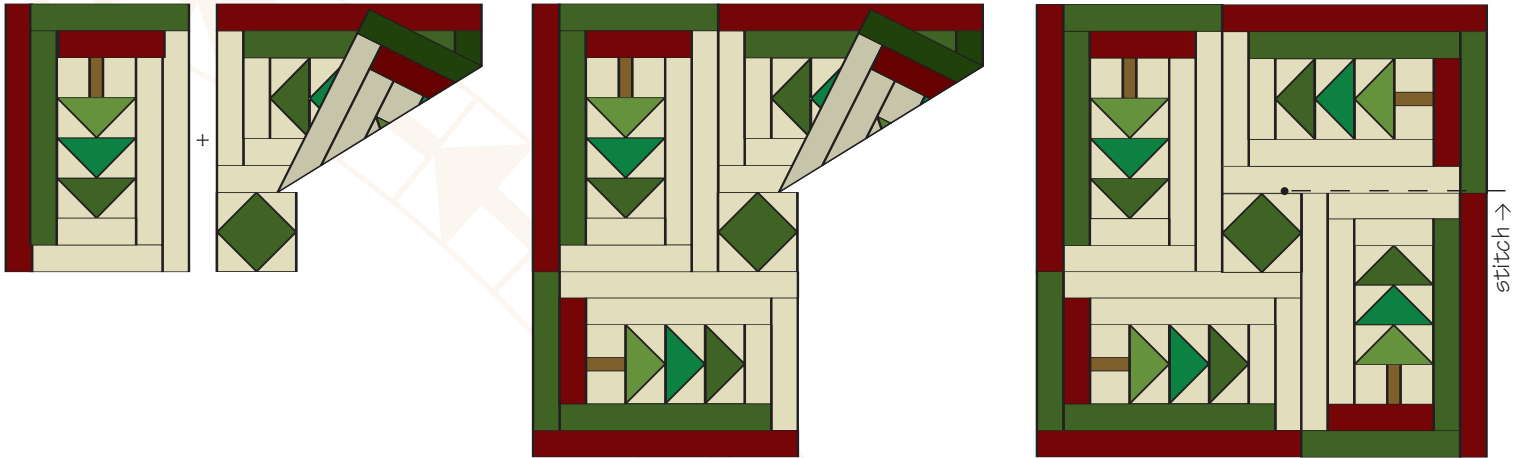
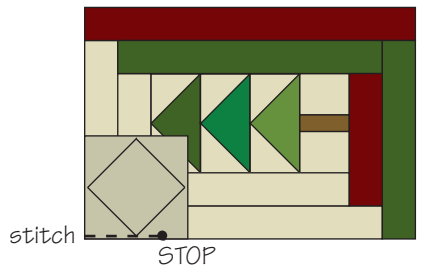

4. Sew tree block to center as shown. Note: blocks may be added with dark or light toward center.
- Sew just half the seam. Press seam toward tree.
 - Continue adding trees counter-clockwise as shown.
 - Return to first seam and continue stitching.

Warning: be sure to assemble in order given to avoid an unattractive secondary design.



5. At this point, the tabletopper is complete, $17\frac{1}{2}''$ \square , and may be finished with binding, after quilting. Or, you may add a border. TIP: if you cut your border $3\frac{1}{2}''$ wide, you may use stars or square in a square blocks in the corners.
