

“Hugs & Kisses” Pillows

—as shown on the cover of new pattern Hugs & Kisses #306

16 oz. fluffy stuffing will fill two pillows

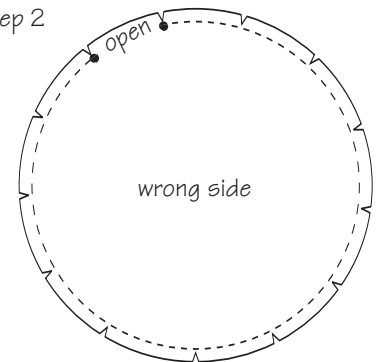
Hug

Fabric – two fat quarters or 1/2 yd.

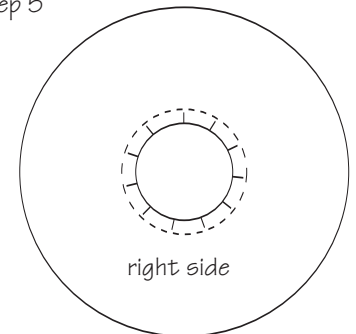
Templates are from your kitchen. Use a platter approximately 17” diameter and a small plate or bowl approximately 6” diameter.

1. Place fat quarters RST or fold 1/2 yd. piece so RST.
2. Trace around platter and cut out circle 1/4” outside line. Use pins as needed to hold two layers together. Stitch through both layers on the line. Leave a 6” opening, backstitched at start and finish.
3. Clip seam allowances slightly around the circle. Turn circle inside out.
4. Place circle flat and draw 6” circle in center. Stitch completely around circle, on the line. Trim out center 1/4” from stitching. Clip seam allowance every 1”.
5. Stuff pillow; close opening with hand stitches.

Kiss

Fabric – two fat quarters; see Note above.

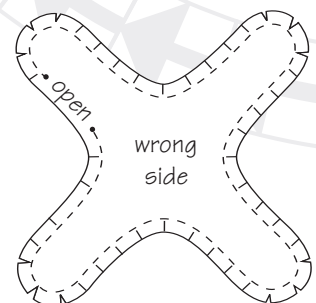
Pattern piece given

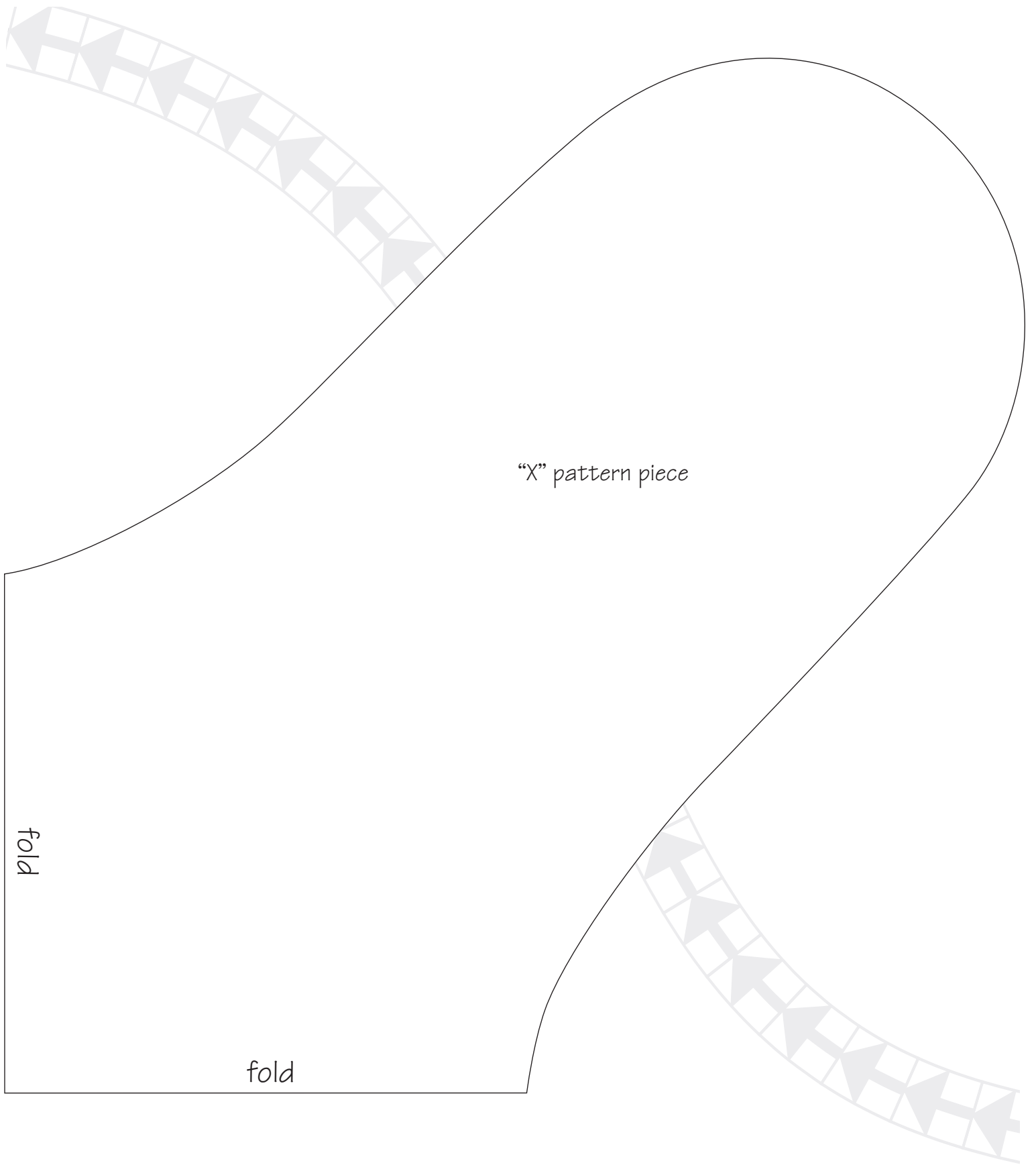
1. Fold one fat quarter twice so that it has two folds. Lay pattern piece so fold marks are aligned. Cut out 1/4” outside edge of pattern piece. Cut two.
2. Pin two X pieces together RST and stitch using 1/4” seam allowance. Leave a 4-6” opening. Backstitching at start and finish. Clip seam allowance.
3. Stuff pillow; close opening with hand stitches.
